Membership & Fee Structure

The season starts on the first Sunday of September, or when the first competitive league fixture is played if that is earlier, and all fees cover the period from then until all league and cup games for the season are concluded.

Unless players advise the Club otherwise, then all players aged over 16 will be registered with the two leagues that the 1st and 2nd Team play in. Players will need to be complete registration by replying to an email from the Leagues confirming their desire to be registered.

Annual Membership & Training Fees

Payable by Bankers Credit (see details below).

This covers the cost of League and FA registrations and insurances, and the cost of a whole year of training (inc 26 weeks on 3G).

This is payable on signing and may be paid in instalments, as long as fully paid by 1 December 2025 (please ask Club Chairman to arrange). If a player leaves the Club during the season, then any refund will only be made at the Club Committee's discretion.

Match Fees

Payable by cash on match day.

Playing Kit

Players will be issued with playing kit on the day on each match, and will return it to the Club at the end of the match. The Match Fee contributes to the cost of laundering the kit. Any damage caused to the kit (other than in the course of the match) will be charged to the player. Socks may not be cut, but players may enquire of the Club of purchasing their own socks and shorts if they so wish.

Code Of Conduct

I agree to abide by the Sovereign Saints Football Club rules, and respect the following code of conduct. I understand that failure to do so will leave me in breach of the Club's Constitution, and may lead to my leaving the Club.

We all have a responsibility to promote high standards of behaviour in the game. Players tell us they want a referee for every match, yet thousands of match officials drop out because of the abuse and intimidation they receive on and off the pitch. Respect the referee and you may just get one for every match this season.

Play your part and observe The FA's Respect Code of Conduct for players at all times.

On and off the field, I will:

- Adhere to the Laws of The Game
- Display and promote high standards of behaviour
- Promote Fair Play
- Always respect the match officials' decisions
- Never engage in public criticism of the match officials
- Never engage in offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour
- Never engage in bullying, intimidation or harassment
- Speak to my team-mates, the opposition and my coach/manager with respect
- Remember we all make mistakes.
- Win or lose with dignity. Shake hands with the opposing team and the referee at the end of every game.

I understand that if I do not follow the Code, any/all of the following actions may be taken by the Club, Sussex County FA or The FA:

- Be required to apologise to team-mates, the other team, referee or team manager
- Receive a warning from the coach
- Receive a written warning from the Club Committee
- Be required to attend an FA education course
- Be dropped or substituted
- Be suspended from training
- Not be selected for the team
- Be required to serve a suspension
- Be fined
- Be required to leave the club
- In addition, The FA/County FA could impose a fine and/or suspension on the Club.
